

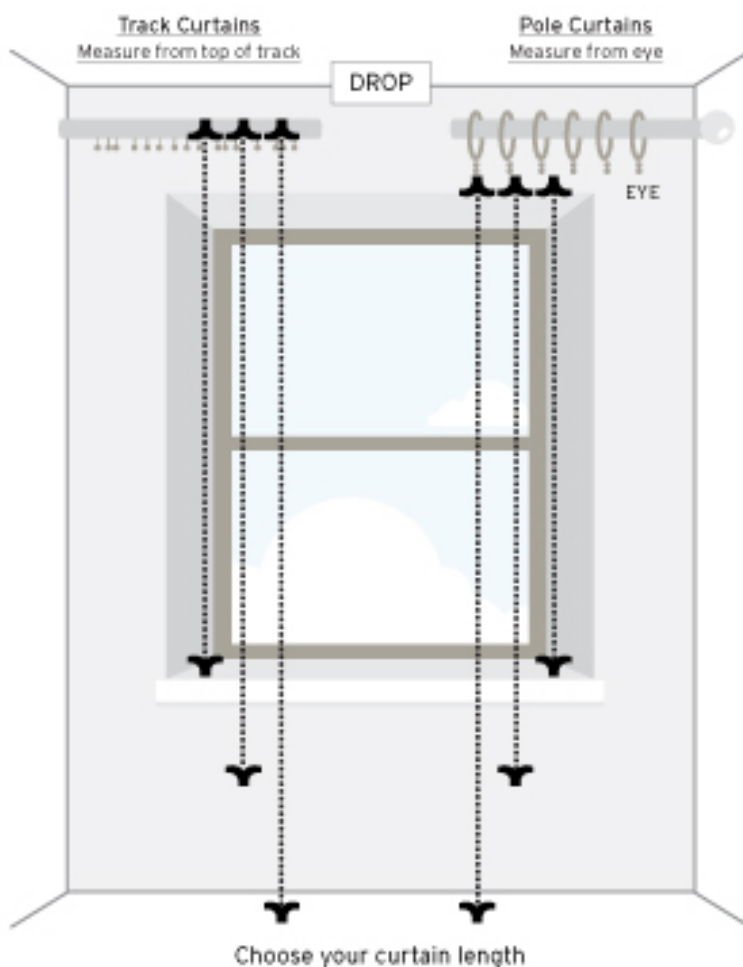
How to measure for curtains

Before measuring for your curtains you need to choose a curtain pole or track, and ideally have the pole or track up so you can measure accurately.

We would advise to position your pole or track 10cm above the window or centralized between the top of the window and ceiling, and wider than the window by 20cm so that the curtains clear the window when they are open to allow maximum amount of light in.

It is always best to measure with another person so the tape measure is held steadily and always use a metal tape measure.

For hand finished curtains, double and triple pleat, hang better from a pole, hung under the pole so the pleats can be accommodated for.



When measuring for a track we recommend measuring from the top of the track to your desired length.

When measuring for a pole we recommend measuring from the eye of the curtain pole rings to your desired length.

For sill length: Measure to the sill and then deduct 1cm. if you would like them below the sill measure to your desired length.

Floor length: Measure to the floor then deduct 2cm, this allows for the curtains to drop once they are hung. If you would like them puddled on the floor, then add 5-10cm to the length.

All of our curtains come pleated up with the curtain hooks in place ready for you to hang up when they arrive.
